2 - BRITISH HELMET

WWII era British Military helmet with liner and elastic strap. Some rust staining to the sand texture, most green paint. FC

3 - U.S M1 HELMET

Most likely Vietnam War era. US/NZ issue M1 helmet. Includes liner and chin strap. GC

4 - TWO WATER BOTTLES

Two NZ Military MKVI water bottles. One complete with cork, felt cover and MKII leather carrier with 191? date. The second is just the blue enamel bottle. VGC

5 - MOUNTED RIFLE BANDOLIER

Original leather bandolier for the NZ mounted rifle brigade. Five leather cells and brass belt buckle connector. No markings. GC

6 - COLT 1911A1 HOLSTER

Black leather model 1916 holster to suit the Vietnam era pistol. US embossed in oval on the flap and makers mark on the back. VGC

7 - K98 AMMO POUCH

Original three cell pebble grain leather ammunition pouch for the WWII German rifle. Makers mark and 1940 dated. GC

8 - D DAY FIGHTING KNIFE

16cm cruciform spike blade fighting knife based on the No4 bayonet with steel knurled grip and No4 steel scabbard with frog. Most likely a reproduction. ExC

9 - 1XL BOWIE KNIFE

Modern made Bowie knife. 15½cm clip point polished blade with 1 * XL GEORGE WOLSTENHOLM AND SON SHEFFIELD makers mark. Brass guard, wooden grips and leather scabbard. 26½cm overall length, appears unused. ExC

10 - GERMAN MG ROD

Cleaning rod for WWII era German machine gun. 78cm with alloy T handle. GC

11 - BRITISH MG ROD

Cleaning rod for WWII era gun. 80cm with steel D ring. GC

12 - 50 CAL CLEANING ROD

US cleaning rod for the M2 50 cal machine gun. 130cm with cast handle. GC

13 - BREN BARREL BAG AND BIPOD

WWII era khaki canvas bag to hold spare parts and barrel for a Bren gun. Australian $D\uparrow D$ marked, plus a MKII type non telescopic bipod. VGC

14 - WWI SMLE RIFLE

British/NZ Military Lee Enfield NO1 MKIII* bolt action rifle. 25" .303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug, marked on the chamber NZ & DP in front as well as serial number (matching at the bolt). The wrist marked Crown GR ENFIELD 1917 SHT LE III*. Metalwork with all over original blue thinning on the edges. VGC woodwork complete with web sling. VGWO&C ALR

15 - WWI G98 RIFLE

German Military WWI Mauser Gew 98 Rifle with 29" barrel, original rear roller coaster sight with original front sight. Action marked JP Sauer 1916 above chamber and Gew 98 on side rail. Mismatched bolt, but other visible numbers match. Stock has been sanded and refurbished with two notches, complete with front band swivel, otherwise G-VGWO&C

16 - VZ33 RIFLE

A Czech Military bolt action carbine. 18½" 8mm cal barrel with original winged foresight and bayonet lug and rear sight

graduated to 1000M. The chamber marked with National crest. The side rail marked CZBROJOVKA AKC SPOLV-BRNE VZ33. Metalwork with near all overall blue. VGC original woodwork complete with swivels. VGWO&C ALR

17 - JUNGLE CARBINE

British WWII Carbine variant of the Lee Enfield. 20" .303 cal barrel with original flash hider, sight and bayonet lug. The receiver with adjustable rear sight. Marked NO5 MKI ROF (F) 8/45 and serial number (matching on the bolt). Metalwork with most original enamel black finish. GC woodwork complete with sling. VGWO&C ALR

18 - P14 RANGE RIFLE

A Parker Hale built range rifle variant of the British WWI Enfield P14 rifle. 26½" .303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The underside marked BSA target quality, made for Parker-Hale etc, chamber marked ERA and *2. The rear target aperture sight is marked Tested by Parker-Hale Ltd. Metalwork has near all blue. VGC woodwork complete with web sling. VGWO&C ALR

19 - NO4 RIFLE

British Military WWII era Lee Enfield No4 MKI* bolt action rifle. 25".303 cal barrel with bayonet lug and sight. The receiver with adjustable sight is marked U.S Property and has Savage S marking. Bolt is mismatched and metalwork has all over finish. GC woodwork complete with sling and 10R magazine. VGWO&C ALR

20 - '07 BAYONET

Australian WWII era pattern 1907 bayonet for the SMLE. 43cm blade with ordnance, plus MA marks and 11 40 date and thinning original finish. VGC wooden grips. Complete with scabbard. VGC

21 - SAWBACK BUTCHER BAYONET

Rare German WWI 98/05 bayonet with sawback. Bright blade, 14.5" long, marked with Waffenfabrik Mauser maker mark and the spine has 1916 Army proofs. Scabbard is steel, original blade with Waffenfabrik Mauser makers mark. Bayonet has VGC wood grips with very nice blade. Scabbard is un-dented and in VGC.

22 - SWEDISH M1915 BAYONET

Rare sword bayonet issued to the Swedish Navy for the M1894/14 Mauser carbine. 50cm blade with ¾ length fullers and marked with crown at the base. VGC wooden grips with scabbard locking latch. Complete with original blued scabbard. ExC

23 - SWEDISH M1914 BAYONET

Swedish Military knife bayonet for the M1894/14 Mauser carbine. 33cm spear point blade in the white marked with Swedish Crowns and C. ExC wooden grip with scabbard locking latch. Complete with original bayonet with thinning blue finish. ExC

24 - K98 BAYONET

WWII German Mauser bayonet. 25cm ExC original blued blade code marked 43 fnj. ExC original wooden grips with flashguard. Correct frog and ExC mismatched scabbard. Hard to find better. ExC

25 - FINNISH BERETTA PISTOL

WWII Finnish Military issue model 1934 Italian Beretta semi auto pistol. 3½". 380acp cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked P Beretta cal 9 CORTO M1934 1942 etc. The frame marked SA and Italian proofs. Metalwork has near all original bright blue and plum colour to the barrel. ExC original grips. ExWO&C CLR

26 - NAMBU TYPE 14 PISTOL

Imperial Japanese WWII semi automatic pistol. 4½" 8mm cal barrel with original sight. Right hand side is marked with Nagoya-Torimatsu factory arsenal marks for November 1943. Metalwork is in ExC with near all original salt blue including the small parts with typical war time machining marks. ExC original wooden grips. Includes its nickel plated magazine. Hard to find a better example. ExWO&C B/CLR

27 - WWI LUGER PISTOL

Imperial German P08 pistol. 4" 9mm barrel, chamber dated 1917 and the toggle marked DWM. Metalwork has overall dulling, original blue with scattered staining and the straw colours have turned dark. Visible numbers are matching except the magazine which is correct WWI type with stained nickel finish. GC original grips. Includes its original makers mark and 1916 dated holster. G-VGWO&C B/CLR

28 - COLT NEW SERVICE REVOLVER

British Military WWI, circa 1915, issue Colt New Service double action revolvers. 51/2" .455 cal barrel with original sight and marked with Colt address, model and calibre. The frame marked with British ordnance marks and rampant Colt logo. Metalwork is in superb condition retaining near all original bright blue with only minor handling marks. ExC COLT logo, hard rubber grips with lanyard ring. A fine example for the discerning collector. ExWO&C B/CLR

29 - DUTCH FN PISTOL

Dutch Army M25 semi auto pistol (FN1922). 41/2" .32acp cal barrel with original sights. The top of the slide is marked with Crown/J for Queen Juliana. The FN legend is in Sans Serif font and metalwork has near all blue. ExC FN logo grips. VGC B/CLR

30 - VZ 50 PISTOL

Czech Military semi auto pistol, circa 1965. 33/4" .32acp cal barrel, slide with original sights and marked VZ OR 50 etc. Near all original blue, ExC bakelite grips. ExWO&C CLR

31 - BERETTA 1934 HOLSTER

Web Desert campaign issue Italian WWII holster for the M34 pistol. GC

32 - HI-POWER HOLSTER

WWII Canadian first pattern khaki web holster for the Inglis-Browning pistol. Ordnance mark with 44 date. In as issued ExC.

33 - NO19 GRENADE

Scarce British Military WWI No19 MKI inert hand grenade was developed for trench warfare and released in early 1916. Complete with its wooden handle and fabric tail. ExC NLR

34 - NO34 GRENADE

British Military No34 Mark III WWI inert hand grenade variant with elliptical shape and central fill hole. Traces of the original paint. VGC NLR

35 - BROWNING SA22 RIFLE

Modern manufacture of the famous semi auto take down 22 rifle. 19" .22LR cal barrel with original sight and receiver with scroll engraving. Metalwork has all original blue, ExC high gloss walnut stocks with 9 shot tube magazine. Includes original box in as new ExWO&C ALR

36 - BROWNING BL22 RIFLE

Japanese made Browning lever action rifle. 20" .22LR cal round barrel with original sights and modified magazine. The metalwork is in ExC retaining all over bright blue and has engraved action. ExC gloss walnut stock. In as new ExWO&C ALR

37 - MARLIN 1894 CARBINE

Vintage, circa 1980, Marlin 1894 lever action carbine. 20" .44 Mag cal round barrel with full mag, original sights and address. Metalwork has all over original blue. ExC original woodwork. Appears unused. ExWO&C ALR

38 - WINCHESTER RANGER CARBINE

U.S Ranger model of the 1894 lever action carbine. 20" 30-30 cal round barrel with original sights. New Haven address, action has cross bolt safety. Metalwork has near all original bright blue ExC beech stock with QD studs fitted. ExWO&C ALR


39 - ALFA CARBINE

Czech Alfaproj revolving carbine. 161/2" 9mm cal with front sight. The rear sight has been replaced with Weaver base.









41 - PATTERN 1874 SWORD

A fine example of a British Royal Marines General Officers sword. ExC 84cm spear point blade with flat back the length of the fullers. Etched design with royal cypher. The ricasso marked E. THURKLE & SONS DENMARK ST SOHO LONDON, brass hilt and guard with black fine shagreen grip. ExC brass scabbard and complete with sword knot. Hard to find better. ExC

42 - BRITISH NAVAL OFFICERS SWORD

Early 20th Century, circa 1906. 80cm spear point blade with flat back extending the length of the fullers. Etched design with cypher and anchor as well as James Aiken. The ricasso marked JR GRAUNT & SON etc LONDON. The brass hilt with RNR imposed. ExC white shagreen grip complete with sword knot plus brass and leather scabbard. A few speckle marks to the blade otherwise ExC.

43 - PATTERN 1805 SWORD

Antique, circa early 19th Century, flag rank Naval Officers sword. The 80cm blade has staining to nearly all of it and some chipping towards the tip. Traces of original gilt towards the base. Stirrup hilt with entwined anchor and lions head. The original ivory grip has a chip and cracked area at the top. F-GC

44 - NAVAL CUTLASS BAYONET

Scarce British Naval pattern 1871 Cutlass bayonet for the Martini Henry rifle 65cm spear point blade. The base marked with Victorian cypher, the other side marked broad arrow WD E 12 6/75. Worn but original leather grip. Black enamel finish to the bowl guard and chape of the leather scabbard. VGC

45 - BRITISH NAVAL DIRK

Antique, circa 1780-1820 British Naval Dirk. 40cm straight double edge blade with wide full length central fullers and scattered pitting. Straight brass guard ferrule and pommel, guard with makers mark F.T. VGC grooved ivory grip, no scabbard, VGC

46 - BRITISH NAVAL DIRK

Pattern 1891 Dirk, circa 1910-1936. 40cm blade etched with GRV cypher and Naval anchor designs. The ricasso is marked GIEVES Ltd, brass guard with anchor, lion head pommel with brass lanyard ring, white shagreen grip. Complete with leather and brass scabbard. VG -ExC

47 - BICORNE HAT

British Royal Naval Officers Bicorne hat, circa 1850's. Black velour with gold bullion braiding. The inside marked West of England Clothing Association, Portsmouth. Includes its hat tin which has lost most of its Japan finish, otherwise ExC.

48 - NAVAL EPAULETTES

A pair of British Naval epaulettes, gold bullion with fouled silver anchors. Contained in their original red baize lined Japan finish tin carry case. VGC

49 - PPSH41 S.M.G

WWII Soviet submachine gun. 10" 7.62 Tok cal barrel with ventilated shroud and original sights. Marked with 1944 date and serial number (matching on stock and guard). Near all arsenal black finish. GC woodwork with sling and its 71R drum magazine. VGWO&C C&P7LR

50 - MARK 5 STEN GUN

British Military WWII Submachine gun. 81/2" 9mm cal barrel with bayonet lug and original sight. The magazine well marked M/78 and has entwined VS proof. Receiver with ordnance marks. Metalwork has most enamel black finish.

GC woodwork with swivel and matching number. Includes its 30R magazine. VGWO&C C&P7LR

51 - MKII STEN GUN

British WWII 9mm S.M.G. 7½" 9mm cal barrel with ventilated shroud and sight. Magazine well is marked STEN MKII (SECO on the underside with serial number). The receiver marked BS and broad arrow. Metalwork with all over enamel finish. Skeleton steel stock and 30R magazine. ExWO&C C&P7LR

52 - THOMPSON S.M.G

Most likely Soviet WWII lend lease submachine gun. 10". 45ACP non fluted barrel with cutts compensator fitted. The receiver with basic battle sight and is marked U.S MODEL of 1928A1 and Savage prefix, Thompson markings and patents. The upper and lower are mismatched. Most overall blue finish. VGC woodowork and includes its 30R magazine. VGWO&C C&P7LR

53 - M1 CARBINE

U.S WWII semi auto M1 carbine. 18" .30M1 cal barrel with original sight and bayonet lug. Marked underwood 11?/43 and flying bomb. The chamber marked U.S Carbine cal .30M1. The rear is fitted with adjustable sight and is marked SAGINAW SG (Saginaw Steering Gear Division G.M). VGC metalwork retaining near all finish. VGC woodwork complete with its 15R magazine. VGWO&C P6&P7LR

54 - THOMPSON AMERICAN LEGEND BOOK

Thompson: The American Legend, The First Submachine Gun by Tracie Hill. This collector grade publication book is a must have for the Thompson collector. Hard cover, large format, 560 pages, B&W pictures. ExC

58 - M3 KNIFE

Modern reproduction of the U.S M3 WWII fighting knife. U.S Camillus brand with leather scabbard. Some age staining to the blade, leather grip and scabbard. FC

59 - M4 BAYONET

Modern Camillus brand reproduction of the WWII era M1 Carbine bayonet. 17cm blade, guard with some rust and pitting. Stained leather grip and scabbard. FC

60 - COLT PYTHON REVOLVER

Desirable vintage, circa 1964, double action revolver. 4" .357 cal ventilated rib barrel and original sights. Marked Python 357 and Colt Hartford address etc. Metalwork is in ExC retaining near all its original bright royal blue with minor holster wear towards the muzzle and some of the edges. ExC original, correct year, walnut gold logo grips. One of the better early examples we have encountered. ExWO&C B/CLR

61 - COLT 150TH ANNIVERSARY REVOLVER

Rare M1873 Buntline single action army revolver. Manufactured in 1986 to commemorate 150 years of Colt firearms. 10" 45LC cal barrel with original sights and marked with Hartford address and 150 years etc. The gun is scroll engraved on the barrel and cylinder as well as gold inlay on the backstrap. Metalwork retains all of its all over royal blue finish. ExC original walnut rampant Colt logo grips. In as new ExWO&C CLR

Seldom seen vintage stainless steel Walther PPK pistol. 3¼" .380ACP cal barrel. The slide marked with Walther banner, Made in U.S.A Under license of Carl Walther etc. and Interarms on the other side. Stainless steel metalwork is in ExC with only minor staining to the safety. ExC black plastic grips. Includes original box with paperwork and extra 6R magazine. ExWO&C CLR

63 - DETONICS POCKET 9 PISTOL

Rare, circa 1985/86 U.S Detonics compact double action 9mm pistol. The overall size slightly smaller than a PPK and has a 3" 9mm cal barrel. The slide with integral sights and is marked DETONICS 9X19 pocket 9. The frame has Seattle WA address. The matte stainless steel metalwork is in ExC as are the original grips and single stack 6R magazine. The pocket 9 was used by Sonny Crocket in Miami Vice as well as Magnum PI and has become an iconic pistol of the 80's. Includes leather holster. ExWO&C CLR

64 - COLT OFFICERS .45ACP PISTOL

Rare seldom seen compact variant of the MKIV series 80 1911 pistol, circa 1986. 3½" .45ACP cal barrel, slide with original fixed sights. Some minor handling scratches to the stainless steel metalwork. ExC original black grips with silver medallion complete with its 6R magazine and original cardboard box. VG-ExWO&C B/CLR

65 - SIG P226 PISTOL

Swiss Police issue Sig Sauer P226 semi auto pistol. 41/4" 9mm cal barrel with Swiss proof, slide with fixed sights and Uri Canton (District Police). Metalwork in ExC with near all finish. ExC original black plastic grips and 15R magazine. ExWO&C B/CLR

66 - TARGET HI-POWER PISTOL

Long slide target variant of the FN pistol. 6" 9mm cal barrel with factory extension and slide with target rear sight. Marked Made in Belgium and American address. Metalwork has near all parkerised matte finish. ExC original pachmayr rubber grips and includes box. ExWO&C B/CLR

67 - COLT COMMANDER PISTOL

U.S Combat Commander variant of the MKIV series 80 semi auto pistol, circa 1990's. 4¼" .45ACP cal barrel, slide with original fixed sights and Colt markings, also on the steel frame. Metalwork has near all original blue, there is a few rub marks to the right hand side of the slide where it has been in the box. ExC original rubber grips. Includes its original box and extra 8R magazine. VGWO&C B/CLR

68 - SNIDER CARBINE

Scarce NZ Military MKIII Constabulary Carbine. 18½" .577 cal barrel with original sights and ordnance marks. Mark III breech with spring catch. The lock plate with Crown/1872 and W H TISDALL 47 WHITTAL ST BIR-MINGHAM address. Metalwork has over all blue turning to nice dark patina. VGC stock fitted with saddle bar and ring, the brass triggerguard is missing the front screw, the butt plate marked NZ190. These particular firearms were ordered by the NZ Government to replace the Callisher & Terry carbine. ExWO&C ALR

69 - MARTINI HENRY CAVALRY CARBINE

NZ Military single shot carbine. 21½" .577/450 cal barrel with original sights and nose cap. The chamber is marked ↑NZ 95/166 and other ordnance marks. Metalwork has thinning dark patina with some scattered pin pricking. Woodwork is missing side nails and the two screws in front of the triggerguard. Includes original rod. GWO&C ALR

70 - BOER MARTINI CARBINE

Unusual Boer War captured and carved British Martini Enfield. 21".303 cal barrel with original sight but missing the rear slider. The receiver with Enfield 1894 Artillery carbine MKIII marks and 1888 date on the other side. The butt stock has been Boer carved on both sides in old German script with names, dates and crests. GWO&C ALR

71 - LEE ENFIELD MKI* RIFLE

Rare early model of the British Military SMLE. 25".303 cal barrel with correct early nose cap and rear sight with bone slider knobs and handguard with steel protectors. Sold Out Of Service mark on the chamber. Bolt with charger guide, the wrist marked Crown ER BSA Co 1905 SHT LE I*. Bolt is matching, receiver and metalwork has overall original blue. VGC woodwork, butt with cap and BSA cartouche and swivels, missing the stock disc. Complete with original sling. VGWO&C ALR

72 - CHILEAN MAUSER RIFLE

Austrian Steyr M1912 contract rifle based on Gew98 for the Chilean Military. 29" 7x57 cal barrel with original sights, bayonet lug and thinning blue. The receiver in the white with crest and MODELO 1912. The side rail is marked Waffenfabrik Steyr Austria. Original stock with correct acceptance marks. Complete with rod and front swivel. VGWO&C ALR

73 - PORTUGUESE MAUSER RIFLE

Model 1904/39 Mauser Verguiero rifle for Portugal Military. 24" 8mm Mauser cal barrel with correct sight wings and bayonet lug. Chamber marked King Carlos the 1st Crown and 8x57JS, the side rail is marked Espingarda Portugueza 6.5 MOD 1904 and DWM address. Metalwork is in ExC with all over bright blue. ExC original woodwork complete with sling, rod and muzzle protector. ExWO&C ALR

74 - BRAZILIAN CONTRACT BAYONET

Mauser bayonet for the Brazilian 1908/34 rifle. 38cm bright steel blade in ExC. Hilt has VGC wood grips with rivets. Crossguard with hooked quillon and muzzle ring. Scabbard is leather with steel fittings and is in VGC.

75 - ARGENTINE MAUSER BAYONET

Argentine M1909 sword bayonet. 40cm blade in the white in ExC with Modelo Argentino 1909, Argentine crest and serial number with maker Weyersberg Kirshbaum Solingen. Hilt has VGC wooden grips, crossguard has hooked quillon and muzzle ring. Scabbard has excellent condition parkerising and matching serial number. VGC

76 - CHILEAN POLICE BAYONET

A M1908 Chilean Police bayonet made from a shortened M1874 Gras bayonet. 28½cm blade with flat inscribed flat back for the Steyr etc. Brass hilt with crest of Republic of Chile. No scabbard. GC

77 - P1879 BAYONET

British Military Martini Henry sword bayonet. VGC 65 ½cm saw back blade marked crown/VR 6/85 plus W↑D/Crown/59. Guard with steel knuckle bow. FC leather grips. Includes leather scabbard, the steel chape has come away. GC

78 - PATTERN 1875 BAYONET

Second type sawback bayonet for the Martini Henry. 52cm blade with half saw back leather grips with some chipping at the top. Includes leather and steel scabbard. GC

79 - SNIDER SADDLE BOOT

Scarce NZ leather saddle boot/bucket for the NZ Tisdall snider carbine (see lot 68). N \uparrow Z marked. The four non buckle straps are repair replacements. GC

80 - NZ TRANTER REVOLVER

NZ Military/Armed Constabulary Tranter model 1878 Army double action revolver. 6" .450 cal octagonal barrel. The frame marked N80Z as well as NZ52 on the other side with patent mark. Metalwork has areas of original blue with some parts flaking to grey. VGC original grips. VGWO&C B/CLR

81 - WEBLEY MKV REVOLVER

Scarce 6" barrel version of the Mark5 WWI British Military .455 cal revolver. Top strap ordnance marked etc and frame with patent information and 1915 date. Metalwork has thinning overall finish. VGC original birds head vulcanite grips with lanyard ring. VGWO&C B/CLR













British Military WWI revolver. 6".455 cal barrel with W&S address and frame with ordnance marks, proofs and 1918 date. Metalwork has near all original finish. ExC original grips with lanyard ring and web holster. ExWO&C B/CLR

83 - WEBLEY MKII REVOLVER

British Military, circa 1890's, revolver. 4" .455 cal barrel with ordnance marks. The frame marked WEBLEY MARK II and ordnance marks. 



This is usually charged forward and you will pay this on receiving your goods. The export process can take around 4-8 weeks. For an estimate of the export license and freight charges please contact us. NZ G.S.T (VAT/sales tax) is only on the commission / buyers premium portion of the items, because this service occurs in New Zealand this must be charged on exports. Items that are not firearms can be sent via NZ postal service and will be charged at that rate plus packaging. Some items with historical significance to New Zealand may not be able to be exported.

- 7. Each package has \$1000 insurance limit, also applies to items sent by post.
- 12. POSTAL BIDDERS: PAYMENT MUST BE MADE ON RECEIPT OF INVOICE, Do not wait until you get your permits, delays hold up payment to our vendors.
- 13. FIRST TIME BIDDERS will need to establish a line of credit by supplying credit card details.
- 14. We accept your bids in good faith however bad debts and change of mind are not acceptable. Recovery of debts will be strongly pursued through legal channels.
- 15. If you are bidding on behalf of another person you are responsible for inspecting the item and payment.
- 16. Measurements and weights are only an approximate.
- 17. Some items with significant historical significance and rarity to New Zealand may not be able to be exported.
