

WWII Imperial Japanese Military type 30 bayonet for the type 38 & 99 rifles. 39½cm blade with Nagoya arsenal mark. Metalwork with dark stained patina with pin pricking. Original wooden grips, complete with steel scabbard. F-GC

WWII SMLE bolt action rifle. 25" .303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The receiver is marked No4 MKI* Long Branch 1943. Bolt and receiver are matching, most overall blue, GC original woodwork with checkered repair/modification of earlier type butt. Missing front swivel, includes sling, magazine and action cover. VGWO&C ALR

16 - JUNGLE CARBINE

British Military WWII bolt action rifle. 20" .303 cal barrel with original sights, flash hider and bayonet lug. The receiver with adjustable rear sight is marked No5 MKI ROF(F) with 7/44 dates. The wrist is stamped England. Metalwork has most original Military black enamel finish, VGC woodwork complete with sling. VGWO&C ALR

17 - AUSTRALIAN LEE ENFIELD RIFLE

WWII era SMLE bolt action rifle. 25" .303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The chamber with sold out of service marks and the wrist marked MA LITHGOW SMLE III * 1942. Metalwork has most overall parkerised finish. Bolt and receiver are matching. The stock has a different number but is Australian Maple and complete with sling. GWO&C ALR

18 - SWEDISH M38 RIFLE

Swedish Military WWII era short rifle variant of the M96 Mauser rifle. 24" 6.5x55 cal barrel with original sights. The chamber is marked Husqvarna etc. 1943. The matching number bolt is the turned down type. Metalwork has thin original blue. VGC original woodwork complete with swivels, stock disc and cleaning rod. VGWO&C ALR

19 - MOSIN NAGANT RIFLE

Soviet Mosin Nagant M91/30 rifle. 28½" 7.62x54R cal barrel with original sights and marked with Izhevsk arsenal marks and 1929 date. The receiver is early hexagonal type with matching number on the bolt and magazine. Metalwork has near all finish. Laminated wood stock with old arsenal repair at the heal. Includes sling. VGWO&C ALR

20 - '07 BAYONET

British Military pattern 1907 SMLE bayonet. 43½cm blade with scattered staining. Ordnance marked, plus Crown/ER 1907 with April 1910 date and Sanderson makers marks. VGC grips complete with scabbard. GC

British Military sword bayonet for the Enfield rifle. 57½cm blade with ¾ fuller and marked WATT and B/78 ordnance mark. The guard with 21.9mm muzzle ring diameter and is marked with serial 1757. Metalwork has near all original typical late war bluing. VGC original grooved grips with handling marks complete with correct original magazine. ExWO&C B/CLR

25 - COLT 1911 PISTOL

US Military, circa 1918, semi auto pistol. 5".45ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked with rampant Colt logo and patent information etc. The right hand side of the slide and frame have had the US property marks removed. Metalwork has most all over re-blue finish with minor staining. GC original diamond pattern wooden grips. Includes its correct 50/50 blue magazine. VGWO&C B/CLR

26 - WWI LUGER PISTOL

Imperial German Military P08 pistol. 4" 9mm cal barrel with original sight. The chamber is dated 1916 and has Military acceptance mark and proofs on the side. The toggle marked DWM. Metalwork has near all its original blue finish with slight holster wear to the side plate and front of the barrel. The small parts have faint straw colours. ExC original walnut grips. All visible numbers including the magazine are matching. ExWO&C B/CLR

27 - SAUER 38H PISTOL

WWII Nazi Germany Military issue semi auto pistol. 3½" .32ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked J.P. SAUER & SOHN etc. The frame and slide are marked with Nazi commercial proof and the trigger guard has correct eagle 37 acceptance mark. The grip also has an engraved 422 unit marking. Metalwork has correct wartime thin original blue and machining marks. ExC original dark brown checkered bakelite grips. A seldom seen German wartime pistol. VGWO&C CLR

28 - GERMAN BERETTA M35 PISTOL

A desirable WWII Nazi German Military issue Italian semi auto pistol. 3½".32ACP cal barrel, the slide is marked P BE-RETTA 7.65 etc with 1944 date. The frame is marked with the German contract 4UT mark and serial number (matching on the slide). Metalwork has near all original blue finish with slight typical plum colour to the frame, VGC original grips. VG-ExWO&C CLR

29 - MAUSER HSC PISTOL

WWII German semi auto pistol. 31/4" .32ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked with Mauser banner and Oberndorf address etc. The trigger guard is marked with Nazi commercial proof. Metalwork has most overall original thinning blue with an area of holster pin prickings and loss at the muzzle. VGC original wooden grips. These were a popular WWII Officers private purchase pistol. GVGWO&C CLR

30 - WWI 1916 LUGER HOLSTER

Brown hard-shell P08 Holster. Nice clear 1916 makers mark with faint ink unit mark. Good overall condition, one belt loop has a tear. VGC

31 - WWI LUGER MAGAZINE

Original P08 pistol magazine Nickel body with wooden base marked with serial number and acceptance mark. A few small areas of loss. VGC B/CLR

32 - LUGER TOOL, GRIPS AND BOOK

Original stripping tool, plus a pair of WWI era original grips and a soft cover book of the 1900 Luger US Test Trials. GC

33 - 8MM NAMBU RELOADING DIES

RCBS brand three die set for the Japanese pistol, plus case forming dies to make 8mm Nambu from .38 special. ExC

British Military MKII** 3 band Snider action rifle. 36½". .577 cal barrel with original sights and ordnance marks. The breech is marked II** and the MK2 lock with ↑WD marks. The lockplate with Victorian Cypher and 1867 Enfield date. Metalwork has near all original brown finish to the bore and traces of case colours on the lock plate. ExC original woodwork with brass furniture and sling swivels. Marked with Enfield cartouche and D/ISC/73 unit mark, complete with rod. Nice collectors example in ExWO&C ALR

35 - SNIDER CAVALRY CARBINE

NZ Military Snider Action MKIII Cavalry Carbine. 19.2" .577 cal barrel with original sights graduated to 600 yards and ordnance marks. The breech is marked N80Z III S 084. The latch is spring catch type and marked BSA and the lock plate with 1880 date and Victorian cypher etc, is type without saddle bar. Metalwork has nice dark original patina, ExC original matching woodwork with brass furniture and steel side nails. Complete with chain. ExWO&C ALR



36 - SNIDER CARBINE

NZ Military Mark III Snider action artillery length carbine converted from a snider short rifle. 21½". .577 cal ordnance marked barrel correctly without bayonet lug and with rifle sights graduated to 800 yards. The chamber is marked N80Z III and serial number (matching on the stock). The latch is spring catch type and the lock plate has National Arms and Ammunition Company logo with 1879 date and Royal cypher. VGC original wooden stock with steel furniture and sling swivel on the trigger guard extension. Complete with sling and rod. A seldom seen variant. VGWO&C ALR

37 - MARTINI HENRY CAVALRY CARBINE

British Military Martini action Cavalry carbine. 21.3" .577/450 cal ordnance marked barrel with original sights. The action is marked Crown/VR/Enfield 1882 etc. III.I. Metalwork has near all original bright blue to the barrel. ExC original woodwork complete with rod. ExWO&C ALR

38 - SNIDER SCABBARD

A rare leather NZ saddle scabbard for the Snider Cavalry Carbine. Marked AC (Armed Constabulary) and complete with straps and steel buckles. G-VGC

39 - SNIDER "SAWBACK" BAYONET

51½cm spear point blade with sawback the length of the fuller. Marked \uparrow WD and ordnance stamp as well as 18½g. The guard with 21mm ring and serial 1591. ExC checkered grips. Complete with its original leather and steel scabbard. VGC

40 - MARTINI HENRY BAYONET

British Military Pattern 1887 MK4 Martini Henry sword bayonet. 46½cm blade with ordnance marks of 1859 and 1891 and with minor staining. GC pinned original grips, complete with leather scabbard. VGC

A seldom seen Royal Irish Constabulary issued Winchester model 1897 riot model shotgun. 20" 12g barrel marked with New Haven address and correct CYL choke marking as well as British proof marks. The slide rail is marked MODEL 1897 -Winchester- etc. Metalwork has dark grey patina with traces of original blue. The original woodwork is marked RIC 42 and has an aged crack at the wrist and as well as missing the butt plate and most likely been shortened slightly. Includes an unfitted Winchester butt plate. GWO&C ALR

43 - WINCHESTER '97 SHOTGUN

US model 1897 pump action shotgun, circa 1942. 30" 12g barrel with bead sight and is marked with New Haven address and MODEL 97 etc with FULL choke designation. Metalwork has most original blue to the barrel turning grey towards the action which has most blue to the right hand side. ExC original woodwork with hard rubber logo butt plate. VG-ExWO&C ALR

44 - WINCHESTER 92 RIFLE

Vintage, circa 1905, lever action rifle. 24" 44-40 cal round barrel with modified full length magazine and original sights and New Haven address. The tang marked MODEL 1892 etc. Metalwork has near all overall re-blue. VGC woodwork complete with swivels. VGWO&C ALR

45 - WINCHESTER '92 RIFLE

Vintage US lever action rifle, circa 1924. 24" .32-20 cal round barrel with original sights and modified full length magazine. Marked with New Haven address and Model 92 etc. The tang is fitted with peep sight. Metalwork has grey metal patina to the frame and thinning blue on the barrel and magazine. VGC walnut stock. VGWO&C ALR

46 - COLT LIGHTNING CARBINE

Antique, circa 1892, pump action carbine. 20" round barrel in 44-40 cal with original sights and marked 44 cal. The magazine is full length (modified to 10R). The receiver with original saddle ring and is marked with the rampant Colt logo. Metalwork has mottled original patina with some bruising. GC original woodwork with handling dings. GVGWO&C ALR

47 - MARLIN 1889 CARBINE

Antique US lever action saddle ring carbine. 20" 44-40 cal round barrel with original sights and marked with New Haven address and 1889 patent date as well as NZ retailer A&W McCarthy Dunedin. The top of the receiver is marked MARLIN SAFETY and has original saddle ring. Metalwork has dark plum patina to the barrel and magazine. The receiver has turned grey and has a few areas of staining to the frame, good condition woodwork. GWO&C ALR

48 - MARLIN FIREARMS BOOK

Rare factory engraved, circa 1974, model 19-3 double action K frame revolver. 4".357 magnum calibre barrel marked in panels SMITH & WESSON, plus S&W .357 MAGNUM. The frame is marked with S&W logo and Springfield address. The frame is relief engraved with foliate designs and retains all original bright blue and case colours. ExC original non checkered grips with medallions. This gun is in superb condition and even retains the original factory protection tape on the cylinder, like new ExWO&C B/CLR

53 - COLT SHERIFFS MODEL REVOLVER

Scarce vintage, circa 1988 Sheriffs model 1873 single action revolver. 3". 44 cal barrel correctly without ejector rod and marked with two line address and COLT SHERIFFS MODEL/COLT S.A.A 44 CAL. Metalwork retains near all original bright blue finish. The frame with Colt patent information and has most bright case colours with some staining on the loading gate and recoil shield. Includes its two factory cylinders in 44-40 and 44 special calibres. ExC original factory ivory grips with Colt medallion logo. VGWO&C CLR

54 - COLT SINGLE ACTION REVOLVER

Colt second generation, circa 1969, model 1873 single action Army model revolver. 4¾".357 magnum calibre barrel marked with one line address and COLT SINGLE ACTION ARMY 357 MAGNUM. The frame is marked with patent information and logo. Metalwork has most original, slightly thinning blue finish as well as faint case colours on the frame with some staining to the hammer. ExC original Colt medallion walnut grips. VGWO&C B/CLR













55 - WOODSMAN MATCH TARGET PISTOL

A rare pre war, circa 1939, Match Target "Bulls Eye" variant of the Woodsman .22lr pistol. 63%" slab sided barrel with Hartford address, patent and model information with the Bulls Eye target logo and original adjustable sights. Metalwork retains nearly all original bright blue finish as well as matte finish on the top of the barrel and slide with only a few very minor handling scratches. ExC original walnut medallion grips that extend below the frame. Complete with its original 50/50 magazine, purple cardboard box and tag. This model is one of the rarest variants of the Woodsman and was only produced for 7 years. Hard to find a better example. ExWO&C B/CLR

56 - ENGRAVED COLT 1855 REVOLVER

A very rare factory engraved model 5A variant of the percussion side hammer revolver, circa 1863. 41/2".31 calibre round barrel marked ADDRESS COL COLT/NEW-YORK U.S.A. The loading lever has Navy model style loading lever latch and 5 shot fluted cylinder. The gun features scroll relief engraving in the typical Colt style on most of the gun. The serial number of the gun is 7084IE for ivory and engraved. The metalwork has no traces of the original finish and fine pinpricking over most of the gun. VGC original checkered ivory grips with a small chip at the base. The gun is contained in its period case with replacement maroon velvet lining and contains an original straight leg iron mold marked COLT PATENT and unbranded American Eagle period flask. Similar examples of engraving and grips are featured on pages 140-150 of The Colt Engraving Book Volume I. Action is at fault, GC NLR

57 - COLT '51 NAVY REVOLVER

Antique percussion fourth model Colt 1851 Navy percussion revolver, circa 1861. $7\frac{1}{2}$ " .36 cal octagonal barrel with Hartford address. The gun has a dovetail foresight and notched rear sight fitted. These are not factory but appear period. The loading lever catch is the thin type. The frame has shield without cap slot. The serial numbers on the frame, barrel, cylinder and arbor are matching and in the 96,000 range. The wedge is unnumbered and the brass large round trigger guard and back strap are matching in the 131,000 range. Metalwork has dark overall patina with rounding to the edges and scattered pinpricking. VGC original walnut grips. Action is strong and indexes well. GWO&C NLR

58 - COLT 1849 POCKET REVOLVER

Antique percussion revolver, circa 1862. 5".31 cal octagonal barrel with original bead sight and marked -ADDRESS SAM <u>L</u> COLT HARTFORD CT- five shot round cylinder with traces of cylinder scene and serial number (mismatched to the rest of the gun). The frame is marked Colts patent. Metalwork has dark overall patina with traces of dulling original finish. VGC original walnut grips. VGWO&C NLR

59 - COLT NAVY BULLET MOLD

Original iron bullet mold for the Colt Navy revolver, marked COLT'S PATENT on the cutter and 36B on the side, dark stained original patina. VGC

50 - COLT POCKET FLASK

A rare original English Colt flask for the pocket revolver. The top is marked COLT POCKET FLASK JAMES DIXON & SONS SHEFFIELD. The top is marked 4/8 5/8 and 6/8 which is the drum positions for the Pocket of Navy calibre revolver. Red brown lacquer with small ding at the top. Complete with original split ring. VG-ExC

61 - WWI MAUSER 98AZ CARBINE

8mm cal barrel with original foresight, integral bayonet lug and stacking hook. Original rear sight graduated to 2000 metres. The chamber is marked ERFURT 1917 with acceptance marks. The side rail is marked Kar98. The bolt is the correct turned down type. Metalwork retains some finish and has Imperial proofs with all visible numbers matching. VGC wooden stock with clear, matching number & cartouches. Comes complete with muzzle cap and sling. A very nice untouched sleeper example. VGWO&C ALR

62 - SMLE MKI*** RIFLE

British Military alteration of the SMLE for the Mark VII ammunition, circa 1914. 25' .303 cal barrel with correct blade fore and rear sights. The wrist is marked Crown/E.R CSA Co Ltd 1905 SHT LE 1***. The bolt is correct type with changer guide and is matching to the barrel. Metalwork has most overall original finish. GC original woodwork complete with lobbing sight, stock disc and sling. A hard to find variant of the SMLE rifle. VG-ExWO&C ALR

63 - LEE ENFIELD NO1 MKIII RIFLE

NZ Military SMLE bolt action rifle. 25' 303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The chamber with N\T and sold out of service marks etc. The wrist marked Crown/GR Enfield 1916 SHT LE III. The bolt, barrel and stock are matching numbers. Metalwork has all over original Military blue finish. VGC woodwork without lobbing sight. Complete with magazine cut off, stock disc and swivels. VG-ExWO&C ALR

64 - SWEDISH MAUSER RIFLE

Swedish Military M96 bolt action rifle. 291/2" 6.5x55 cal barrel with original sights and subtile English proof marks. The chamber marked Carl Gustaf 1902 etc. Metalwork retains near all original blue and only minor staining to the white metal bolt handle. All visible numbers are matching. VGC original woodwork complete with stock disc, swivels and rod. VG-ExWO&C ALR

65 - SWISS M1911 RIFLE

Swiss Military Schmidt Rubin straight pull rifle. 31" 7.5x55 cal barrel with original sights, bayonet lug and stacking hook and marked with Swiss Cross etc. Metalwork has thinning original finish turning white on the receiver. Original woodwork with armourers repair at the wrist. Complete with swivels and 6R magazine. GWO&C ALR

66 - MARK I TRENCH KNIFE

Rare WWI U.S. Military second pattern Mark I fighting knife. 161/2cm double edge blade correctly without makers mark and retains some of the original blue finish and has some scattered pinpricking and staining. ExC original blackened bronze knuckle duster grip marked U.S 1918 L.F & C-1918 (Landers Frary & Clark). Correct original blued end nut. Without scabbard. GC

67 - WWI FIGHTING KNIFE

A conversion of a pattern 1888 bayonet into a Trench fighting knife. The blade has been shortened to 19cm and sharpened on both edges. Metalwork has overall pitted finish. GC wooden grips complete with original shortened scabbard.

68 - FAIRBAIRN SYKES 2ND PATTERN DAGGER

A nice highly collectable example of a British WWII Commando dagger. ExC 17cm full length blade that hasn't been re-sharpened. The Wilkinson Sword and FS fighting knife logos on are sharp and retain the dark grey colour of the inlay. Near all blue to the elongated oval cross guard. The knurled grip retains most of the original black finish. VGC original leather scabbard. The original elastic strap is complete but stretched. ExC

69 - FRENCH WWI TRENCH KNIFE

A seldom seen original French Military trench knife. The 18cm blade is made from a shortened 1874 Gras bayonet with its signature flat back. Brass cross guard and turned wood handle. Includes its original copper shortened bayonet scabbard. Provenance Ian Rasmussen Collection. ExC

70 - GERMAN WWI SAWBACK BAYONET

KS 98 bayonet with distinctive 'eagle back' pommel for Kar98 or Gew 98 Rifle. C.G Haenel maker marked with 1914 date. Wooden grips secured by two screw bolts. GC blade, slight split to one grip, comes with original scabbard. Scarce and desirable bayonet. G-VGC

71 - PATTERN 1903 BAYONET

British Military P1903 for the early SMLE rifle. Royal Cypher and 1903 on blade with good blueing at the base of





All firearms, parts and ammunition (excluding antique) require a mail order form from a Police Officer validating your license. This form is forwarded on your behalf to us from your local Arms Officer / Police station. Pistols & restricted weapons require a permit to procure before delivery

EXPORT - We can export to most countries. Firearms including antique have to be exported via air freight. We have a freight forwarder who can organise this for you. An export license will need to be obtained. We charge a \$80 fee for our time in organising the export and packaging, The freight forwarder will charge you for the NZ export license and the freight for the firearm(s). This is usually charged forward and you will pay this on receiving your goods. The export process can take around 4-8 weeks. For an estimate of the export license and freight charges please contact us. NZ G.S.T (VAT/sales tax) is only on the commission / buyers premium portion of the items, because this service occurs in New Zealand this must be charged on exports. Items that are not firearms can be sent via NZ postal service and will be charged at that rate plus packaging. Some items with historical significance to New Zealand may not be able to be exported.
